Facts About The Scholarship Fund

- For families residing and attending Catholic schools within the Archdiocese of Newark (Bergen, Essex, Hudson and Union Counties).
- Scholarships are based upon financial need and are awarded without regard to religion, race or ethnicity.
- The average amount of the SFIC Scholarship Grants for the 2010-2011 academic year is \$1,000 for Elementary and High School students entering grades K through 12 (All Pre-Kindergarten programs are not eligible).
- Applications will be available starting October 15, 2009 at your Catholic School office and at www.sficnj.org.
- Applications must be postmarked by January 15, 2010.
- Financial documentation is required along with the completed application.
- A \$15 non-refundable Money Order payable to SFIC is required (one per family). No personal checks will be accepted.
- Only one scholarship per student. Students in grades K-8 receiving tuition assistance from The Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF) program are not eligible for the SFIC scholarship.
- All applicants will be notified of our decision after March 15, 2010.
- Scholarship payments are made directly to the schools.
